

Groups of 4 people:

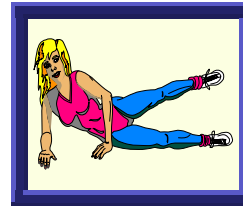
- 1) Ask the teacher for the **OFTEN** cards.
- 2) Give 8 of the **PICTURE CARDS** to each group member.
- 3) Put the **WORD CARDS** on this page.

**Put the OFTEN
Word Cards here
(face down).**

Student 1:

- Pick up a **WORD CARD**.
- Make a sentence using the word on the card and one of your pictures. Here is an example:

“I do aerobics every morning.”



**Every
morning**

Student 1:

- Put both cards on the table in front of you.

Continue this game. Each student picks up a word card and makes a sentence, using a picture card. If the sentence is good, the student keeps both cards. If the sentence is not good, the word card is put back in the pack.

Groups of 4 people:

- On the next page there are a lot of clocks. This is the **CALLER'S SHEET**.
- One student is the **CALLER**. This person uses the **CALLER'S SHEET**.
- Other students turn to the following 2 pages.
- Let's play **BINGO**!
 - You need a horizontal row of 4 clocks for **BINGO**!
 - You only need three clocks if there is a “**FREE**” square in the row.
- Play **BINGO** again with a different **CALLER**.
