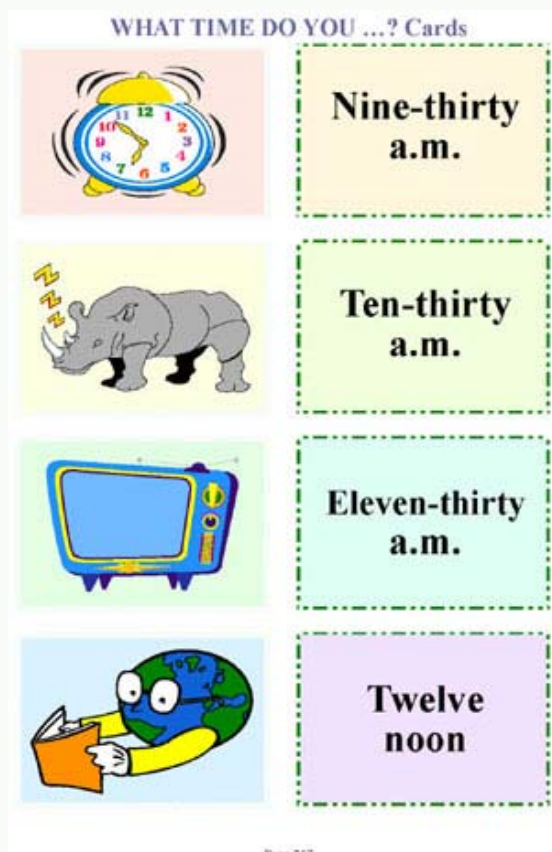


What time do you ...?

This is a *Telling the Time* game, based on ideas in Chapter 5.
Play this game in groups of at least 4 people.

- Ask the teacher for the WHAT TIME DO YOU ...? Cards:



Version 1:

- Put the cards face down on the table, in two piles (PICTURES, WORDS).
- Student A picks up a **PICTURE CARD** and a **WORD CARD**. He/she makes a sentence using the cards. E.g.: *I wash my teeth at two o'clock in the morning.*
- If the other group members agree that the sentence is true, Student A can keep both cards.
- If the other group members think that the sentence is not true, the cards are returned to the bottom of each pile.

Version 2:

- Put the **PICTURE CARDS** face down on the table, in one pile.
- Share the **WORD CARDS** between all the group members.
- Student A picks up a **PICTURE CARD** and makes a sentence using any one of his/her **WORD CARDS**. E.g.: *I put on makeup at three thirty p.m.*
- If the other group members agree that the sentence is true, Student A can keep both cards, and put them on the table in front of him/her.
- If the other group members think that the sentence is not true, the **PICTURE CARD** is returned to the bottom of the pile, and the **WORD CARD** is returned to the student's collection.

Version 3:

- Make a new game using the **PICTURE CARDS** and the **WORD CARDS**.
