Norway (A), project 3

Each year Norway produces 8,600,000 cubic metres (m³) of untreated wood (wood in the rough), which is exported (526,000 (m³)), sold for fuel, or made into products such as sawnwood, panels, woodpulp, paper, or paper board. The average figures for 1993 to 1995 show that Norway exported 790,000 m³ of sawnwood, 217,000 m³ of panels, 557,000 Metric tonnes (m.t.) of woodpulp, 1,777,000 m.t. of paper and paper board, and 135,000 m.t. of waste paper, each year. Norway imports fuelwood (8,000 m³) and other forestry products. Figures for 1993 – 1995 show that Norway imported 2,511,000 m³ of wood in the rough, 687,000 m³ of sawnwood, 152,000 m³ of panels, 90,000 m.t. of woodpulp, 367,000 m.t. of paper and paper board, and 35,000 m.t. of waste paper.
